We would like to invite you to join in with our third **art festival** called Earth, Air and Water culminating in an exhibition this autumn 2008.

Earth, Air and Water is an art initiative in partnership with Chichester Harbour Conservancy, the Friends of Chichester Harbour and Pallant House Gallery in Chichester for artwork **inspired** by Chichester Harbour to be exhibited at Pallant House Gallery throughout October.

the initiative gives the Conservancy the **opportunity** for people to discover and learn more about the **natural beauty** of the harbour through art and to have the chance of having their artwork exhibited in a prestigious Gallery. The Friends of Chichester Harbour are pleased to support the initiative by sponsoring the Private Viewing at Pallant House Gallery and a series of workshops with local schools.

Pallant House Gallery will sponsor Earth, Air and Water by hosting the **exhibition** at the Gallery and arranging an Adult Art Workshop (13 July) that can be booked by the public in preparation for their artwork.

All artworks submitted to Earth, Air and Water will be considered for hanging in the exhibition space in the Gallery Education Room but the final selection will depend on the work submitted and the available exhibition space.

Important dates for 2008:

Artworks must be finished and taken to Pallant House Gallery between Wednesday 24 September and **Saturday 27th September latest**. It is planned to have the hanging completed by 5pm on Tuesday 30 September.

Exhibition open at Pallant House Gallery from **Wednesday 1 October to Friday 31 October 2008** inclusive. Gallery opening times: Mondays Closed / Tuesday-Saturday 10 – 5 pm / Thursday 10 – 8 pm / Sunday 12.30 – 5pm

Private Viewing sponsored by Friends of Chichester Harbour for all participants at Pallant House Gallery **Saturday 4 October** 10 am for one hour. Entry to the Earth, Air and Water exhibition and private viewing is free. Normal entry fees apply for the main galleries.

All works must be **collected** from the exhibition on **Saturday 1 November**. Any uncollected work will be disposed of.

| Work Submitted | All work should be suitably framed (no clip frames) and without fixings on the back and labelled with the title, media, artist's name and phone number.

Photographers may submit prints (mounted) and/or CD/DVDs of work.

| Sale of work | Participants may choose to offer their work for sale. In this case, the asking price must be included with the details on the label. Please allow 10% commission as a donation to the environmental work of the Friends of |

Chichester Harbour. Any potential purchasers will be instructed to phone the artist direct regarding the sale. Once a sale is made, the artist is asked to kindly send a cheque for 10% of the selling price to the Friends of Chichester Harbour, c/o Earth, Air and Water (Judi Darley), Chichester Harbour Conservancy, Itchenor, Chichester, PO20 7AW. The seller needs to inform the purchaser that the artwork must be collected at the end of the exhibition on Saturday 1 November. The seller must also inform the staff of the Reception desk at Pallant House Gallery that a sale has been made, and the name of the purchaser.

- Certificates** A commemorative certificate will be given to each participant
- Judging** Final selection of artwork for the exhibition will be decided by Pallant House Gallery
- Hanging** The Gallery will be responsible for hanging artwork submitted by the general public.
- Private Viewing** A private viewing sponsored by the Friends of Chichester Harbour will be held for all participants on Saturday 4 October 2008 at Pallant House Gallery between 10 and 11 am
- Use of artwork** Chichester Harbour Conservancy and Pallant House Gallery reserve the right to photograph and reproduce any artwork submitted for Earth, Air and Water on their websites and in promotional leaflets for any non-commercial purposes.
- Collection of Works** All participants must collect their artwork on Saturday 1 November between 10.30 am and 4 pm. The organisers reserve the right to dispose of any work not collected after this time.
- Liability** Pallant House Gallery and Chichester Harbour Conservancy accept no liability for any injuries incurred, loss of possessions or damage to work displayed during the events and exhibition. Entry of the event signifies acceptance of these conditions.
