

Chichester Harbour Conservancy – 2018 Photography Competition

Terms and Conditions

The competition will be governed by the following rules:

1. The categories for the Chichester Harbour Photographic Competition 2018 are Wildlife, Economy, Habitat and Recreation. Each theme is open to personal interpretation.
2. Chichester Harbour Conservancy's decision as to the eligibility of individual photographs will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
3. Photographs entered must have been taken within the boundaries of Chichester Harbour AONB.
4. Photos can be portrait or landscape, but to feature on the cover of the Harbour News, the image must be portrait and of a high enough resolution for reproduction in print. Photos can be in colour or black and white.
5. Entries must be made by posting the image on either Twitter or Instagram, tag Chichester Harbour Conservancy:

use the hashtag #photoChiHarbour.

Entries can also be made by email to info@conservancy.co.uk and the subject must say Photo Competition 2018.

Entries made on facebook will not be accepted.

6. Entrants under the age of 16 need the consent of a parent or guardian to enter.
7. Chichester Harbour Conservancy will only ever use personal details for the purposes of administering the competition and in accordance with Chichester Harbour Conservancy's Privacy Policy. Chichester Harbour Conservancy will only keep personal details for as long as is necessary to fulfil these purposes. Chichester Harbour Conservancy will not pass on personal information to any third party other than for image copyright purposes.
8. The competition closes at 23:59 on 30th September 2018. Entries received after this date will not be considered.
9. Chichester Harbour Conservancy cannot accept any responsibility for any problem with internet service provider, network or other system which may result in any entry being lost or delayed. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt.
10. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries or

their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured. Where an individual or a residential property belonging to someone other than the photographer is featured, the photographer must seek permission and be prepared to provide written consent, if requested. Further, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs.

11. We are looking for original photographs, so entries must not have won any national competition prize previously. For the purposes of this competition, 'national' refers to the whole of the UK – or to individual national competitions in England, Wales, Scotland or Northern Ireland.
12. Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit to Chichester Harbour Conservancy. By entering the competition all entrants grant to Chichester Harbour Conservancy the right to publish, exhibit and use their photographs on Chichester Harbour Conservancy's website, social media channels, in Harbour News and in any Chichester Harbour Conservancy marketing materials, in perpetuity. Winning entrants also agree to take part in post – competition publicity. No fees will be payable for any of the above uses.
13. While we make every effort to credit photographers, including in printed reproductions of their work, we cannot guarantee that every use of the photographs will include the photographers' names. Entrants must ensure that the photograph is not used to publicise or promote companies, individuals, organisations or causes.
14. By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules and Chichester Harbour Conservancy reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time and in its absolute discretion if Chichester Harbour Conservancy has reason to believe that an entrant has breached these rules.
15. Chichester Harbour Conservancy reserves the right to cancel this competition or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
16. If the winner is unable to be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made, Chichester Harbour Conservancy reserves the right to either offer the prize to a runner up, or to re-offer the prize in any future competition.
17. There is no cash or alternative prize on offer
18. This competition is administered by Chichester Harbour Conservancy.
