<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meet our staff at the Departure point. Lifejackets are provided for school parties. A short introduction and activities aboard the Solar Heritage. The boat trip lasts between 45 – 90 minutes depending on weather conditions and the needs of your group. If you would like to bring 2 or 3 classes we can split the group, with 2 consecutive boat trips and with an activity and walk on the shoreline for the group ashore.</li> <li>• After the trip we offer a session of activities at our Education Centre in Dell Quay or on the beach at West Wittering and East Head.                  Dell Quay -Explore the shoreline habitat with a hunt for creatures and plants. Build crab homes. Create 'sticky pictures' to take home.
