

Easier Access Route Itchenor

This route begins in the Itchenor car park and follows the John Davis permissive path direct from the car park to the shoreline. It then goes along a good path to a viewpoint looking across the Harbour to the Bosham Channel. Return the same way if you are using a wheelchair, or if not you can go via a path through the boatyard to reach the viewing platform by the Harbour Office.
