Prinsted and Nutbourne Circular

A stroll along easy paths, though with one old-fashioned stile. This route follows the Chichester Harbour shoreline from the pretty village of Prinsted to Nutbourne Bay with splendid views of the Thorney Channel and back through countryside and a commercial orchard. This walk is excellent for bird watching in the wintertime on the mudflats at low tide. In summer watch the dinghy sailing at high tide.


